All schools have access to

- The School Games pathway: Entry into inter school (level 2) School Games, SSP Virtual Competitions, SSP competitions and festivals. Winners of inter school events progress to county events (where these pathways exist).

- Support with developing Change 4 Life or other clubs/activities targeting inactive children.

The main emphasis of this is supporting teaching and learning of as many children as possible through high quality inter school events.

- Support with identifying and guiding specialist PE teachers (this could be individual school, cluster of schools or cluster of schools working with high school Specialist PE Teacher) and/or specialist Sports Coaches
